The faculty consists of 17 certified teachers, 1 corporation psychologist, 9 instructional aides, 1 preschool teacher, 1 corporation school resource officer (SRO), 1 secretary, 1 corporation nurse, 4 food service staff, and 3 custodians.

Demographics:

Oregon-Davis Elementary School is part of the Oregon-Davis School Corporation which is located in Hamlet, Indiana in Starke County in the northwest region of the state. Oregon-Davis Elementary School is a consolidation of Oregon Township and Davis Township which have a combined population of 6,298 people as of the 2010 census. The elementary building was built in 1981, and renovated in 1999 to add additional classrooms.

The community offers potential resources. We are within 45 minutes of Notre Dame, Ancilla College, Indiana University South Bend, Ivy Tech, Purdue Northwest, Valparaiso University and Bethel College. The South Bend International Airport is the only major airport in the area. In our small area there are businesses that employ the parents of our students, which include; Farm Fertilizer, Hensler's Tree Farm, Starke County Co-op, Norton Packaging, Koontz Lake Supermarket, The Food Mart, and Grovertown Truck Stop.
