## SCHOOL CLOSINGS & DELAYS

When school is delayed or closed an all-call goes to all parent/guardian phone numbers on record. Notices will be on WKVI, WSBT, WNDU, Fox 28 television stations and websites, along with the school website.

## OREGON-DAVIS TELEHEALTH CENTER

The Oregon-Davis TeleHealth Center allows your child to be seen by a healthcare provider without leaving school. A parent or guardian doesn't have to be present, but a parental consent form must be signed for services to be provided. The Oregon-Davis Telehealth Center will be open from 7:00 AM to 2:00 PM on days when school is in session.

Available services: diagnoses and treatment for acute illness (such as strep throat, ear infections, rash, and flu) and minor injuries. Limited laboratory testing. Your insurance will be billed for services provided in the clinic. If you do not have insurance, services will be provided on a sliding-fee scale that is based on the parent's income. If you or your child is uninsured, please contact HealthLinc at 1-888-580-1060 and we will assist you with obtaining insurance. **Consent form for the Telehealth Clinic needs to be filed every year.** If your student had a consent on file last year please complete a new form for this school year. Forms can be found in the school offices.

## STUDENT SPORTS PASSES

Any Oregon-Davis student must have either an All-Sports Pass or buy a ticket at the door, \$5.00 admission per event. An all-sports pass is only \$10.00 for the entire school year for **all** events. Students can purchase the pass at the main office at the elementary or Jr/Sr high school.
